By Laws on Election of Zonal Councillors (extract)
Voting Procedure

If there is only one candidate for a position, that person is elected unopposed without the need for any ballot to be conducted.

If there is no candidate for a position, that position is treated as a casual vacancy. A person appointed to fill a casual vacancy must be eligible to represent that zone as specified above.

Every affiliated club in a zone is entitled to vote to elect the councillor for that zone.

If a vote is required for a zone, the Secretary of the NSWBA will send voting information to all affiliated clubs in the zone at least three weeks before the election. Clubs must return their votes to arrive at least two days before the election.

There will be a maximum of four votes per club, based on the most recently available number of "home club" members in each club as shown on the ABF Masterpoint Centre website.

The number of votes allocated to each club is:

1 to 20 members: 1 vote 21 to 100 members: 2 votes 101 to 500 members: 3 votes 501 or more members: 4 votes

A club cannot split its votes between candidates but must exercise all votes in favour of a

particular candidate, if it votes at all.

Votes will be counted at the Annual General Meeting of the NSWBA. Each of the ballots for the five Zonal Councillor positions will be decided on a "first past the post" basis, if there is more than one candidate for a position.

In the event of an equal number of votes being cast for each candidate, or no votes being cast for any candidate, the matter is to be decided by drawing lots.
