## COUNTRY TEAMS CHAMPIONSHIP 2011

December 2010

### To The Tournament Secretary: all NON-METROPOLITAN affiliated clubs

Following on from the successful running of this event in 2010, the Country Teams section of the 2011 State Teams Championship will again be contested in three divisions: Northern, Southern and Outer Metropolitan. All Divisional Finals will be held over three sessions on the weekend of 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> July. Each divisional winner will be eligible to play in the State Teams Final at the NSWBA on the weekend starting on Friday evening 9<sup>th</sup> December. The NSWBA will offer subsidies to all representative teams.

The Convener for 2011 is Louis Koolen and each Division will have its own coordinator.

Any clubs not included in this list should also contact the Convener.

All non-metropolitan affiliated clubs are invited to conduct one or two events in order to qualify teams to play in their Regional Final. Clubs may run a daytime and/or an evening event.

Clubs not wishing to run a qualifying competition may nominate one team per 50 home club members or part thereof with a limit of three teams. All players in a nominated team must be financial members of the nominating club.

Clubs that wish to run a Regional Final should contact their Divisional Coordinator by Friday 4<sup>th</sup> February. Clubs that wish to run a Divisional Final should contact their Divisional Coordinator by Friday 4<sup>th</sup> February.

Friday 4<sup>th</sup> February: Deadline for applications from clubs to host Regional Final

Friday 4<sup>th</sup> February: Deadline for applications from clubs to host Divisional Final

Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> June: Deadline for completion of Club Qualifying events

Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> June: Deadline for completion of Regional Finals

Saturday 25<sup>th</sup> June: Deadline for entries to the Divisional Finals

Sat 2<sup>nd</sup> & Sun 3<sup>rd</sup> July: Date of Divisional Finals

Fri 9<sup>th</sup> – Sun 11<sup>th</sup> December: Date of John Arkinstall State Teams Finals at NSWBA
