Entry Fee: \$360 per team (GST incl.)

Format (Swiss or Round Robin) will be dependent on the number of entries.

Subject to Council ratification, the top team and another competing pair will represent NSW as a transnational team in the Commonwealth Nations Bridge Championship in Broadbeach from 14th to 18th February 2018.*

The NSWBA will pay the CNBC entry fee and provide the representative team with a grant of \$1800.

Red Masterpoints at State Championship level will be awarded.

*The Commonwealth Nations Bridge Championship is held in conjunction with the Commonwealth Games.

The top 8 placed transnational teams will qualify to the CNBC Finals.

Note that the Finals for the CNBC clash with the Gold Coast Congress Bobby Richman Pairs.

The GCC will refund BRP entry fees for late withdrawals, but will not accept last minute BRP entries.

- All entrants must be members of a club affiliated with the NSWBA.
- Entries close at 5.00pm on Friday 15th December. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Director.
- All substitutions must be requested **in advance** by submitting the online form at www.nswba.com.au/forms/substitute.asp. See the Supplementary Regulations for the number of substitutions allowed.
- The winning team will augment a pair in accordance with the Supplementary Regulations.
- Yellow systems are not permitted.
- Players must live over 100 km from the NSWBA to be eligible for the country player subsidy.
